We have finally scheduled a date for a member orientation party and that will be on Friday, September 26 th starting at 6:00pm. Food will be supplied and I will have Member handbooks made up for everyone that would like a hard copy. I will send out a flyer with more information this week. Now that Labor Day is over, we were talking about doing something like a "First Friday" type of gatherings/Happy Hours to help everyone to get to know each other and give the newer members an opportunity to ask questions and get to know the dos and don'ts on the NSC, especially if you are unable to attend the orientation party. We would encourage all members to volunteer in hosting one of these, or any other party of your choice. It will help you to get to know others and them you.

Just a few things I would like to make very clear to all of the members.

1 – There are ONLY MEMBERS allowed behind the bar! No non-members and absolutely NO children not even to get snacks! This is extremely important because of our liquor license. If we lose our liquor license, that would be a very detrimental time for our club.

2 – There have been several occasions where people have come to the club after a weekend of activity, or after a private event/party and the clubhouse has not been as clean as it should be. I am going to create a checklist that will be part of the Private Event request form and the host will be responsible for making sure all procedures are followed and completed. It would also be greatly appreciated if you are at the club and notice that the floor needs sweeping, especially around the bar stools, if the tables/bar needs wiping down, if the floor needs a quick mopping, or if the rug needs vacuuming, please help out and take care of it. We do not have a cleaning service, so it is everyone's responsibility to pitch in. It was suggested at our last Board meeting to form a cleaning committee to take care of other things like washing windows, mirrors, bathrooms, maybe once or twice a month to keep on top of it. Let me know if you would be interested in this.

3 – If you have children that wear diapers, please don't leave dirty diapers in the bathroom garbage cans. At the very least, please dispose of them in the dumpster across the street, or take them home with you. I will get small garbage bags for the bathroom with the changing table. If the dumpster is locked, the combination for the lockbox on the fence next to the dumpster can be found in the coatroom. There is also a key for the dumpster on the whiteboard in the coatroom, but it is extremely important that it is returned immediately after using it.

4 – Lastly, if you are throwing out food, same as the diapers, please don't just toss it into the garbage cans inside the clubhouse, take it out to the dumpster. We don't want it sitting in there for potentially days.
