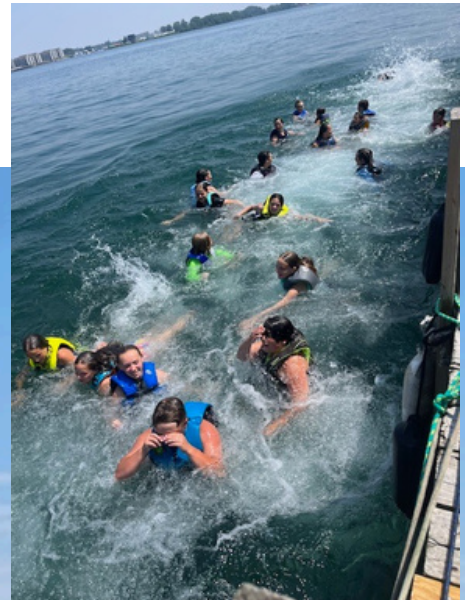
Rear Commodore Keith Conover

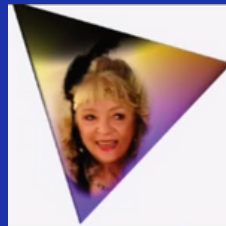
