NSC Beverage and Bar Policy Reminder:

ALL soda and alcohol beverages consumed on NSC property must be purchased from the club bar. The money the club takes in from bar sales is a major part of our income and business plan. NSC's liquor license also requires that all alcohol onsite is from a NY state distributor. If you want to drink a full bottle of wine, please contact bar manager Tony Albano in advance to arrange for a corking fee. Store bought gifts of bottles of alcohol given to someone at the club for things such as a birthday party cannot be consumed at the club. Soda or alcohol beverages in the pool area must also be purchased from the bar. Another requirement of our NY state liquor license is that all non-NSC members sign in the registry book at the door before they are served. Everyone's cooperation in adhering to and to reminding other members and guests of these requirements is greatly appreciated.






