If you are interested in having a private party/event at the NSC this year, please email me at ziey481@gmail.com and I will get it on the calendar as "TENTATIVE" until you fill out the Private Club Use Agreement form and include the (2) checks required, one \$100.00 (refundable) security deposit and one for the cost of the rental (\$250.00 for a NSC member hosting the party). Your date will NOT be secured until we receive all necessary paperwork and checks. It's on a first come, first serve basis only!

PLEASE NOTE: THERE ARE NO RESERVED, PRIVATE EVENTS ALLOWED ON SATURDAYS OR SUNDAYS STARTING MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND AND CONTINUING THROUGH LABOR DAY MONDAY UNLESS A SPECIAL REQUEST IS SUBMITTED TO AND APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS! These are extremely rare and are on a case-by-case basis only. In other words, don't expect these requests to be approved! However, you can organize and host a club event during those weekend days/nights.

I am a part of the annual Kentucky Derby Party, which is one of the most popular events.
