
Hi everyone!


As we've had an influx of new members the last year, I thought I'd list the procedures for using/paying your **BAR CHIT** (this should also serve as a friendly reminder to our "seasoned" members (5) When using a Bar Chit, please list the drinks consumed accordingly. At the end of the evening, I encourage you to simply put the chit

<u>in the safe behind the bar</u>. There is no need to pay it off that day – you will be sent a monthly Chit List that shows what you owe. In the event you have to use cash (not recommended), you MUST put your chit AND the cash in an envelope together (provided next to the safe), AND write on it <u>who you are, the date</u> <u>and the amount contained</u>...please do NOT randomly put chits and cash separately in the safe (or "fold" your cash inside the chit); you are asking for problems trying to have the two reconciled correctly.

- When hosting a <u>Private party</u>, you will be given a "**Party chit**" which shows all the drink types available for sale. You MUST fill this out and submit payment <u>at</u> <u>the end of your event</u>; again, please do not put cash in the safe without an envelope, and do not combine your party chit with additional random single chits from members – the party chit alone is to be used, no individual chits.
- When hosting a <u>Club Event</u>, there will be a "Master Chit" sheet with members names listed – similar to the party chit, just mark down which drinks were served. When hosting a club event, it is the responsibility of those hosting to complete an event form along with the master chit list (forms provided by the bar committee).

I know this all sounds a bit confusing, but it is an honor system that we have successfully used for decades - it works well when followed. Remember, you do NOT need to pay your chit at the end of the day; you will be sent a monthly Chit List that I encourage you to pay by **check or PayPal**. Using cash and cash in envelopes does not work well (you may think it's only a few dollars here and there, but multiply that by 10-50+ members...it's a bit of a nightmare trying to figure things out!). Finally, your club chit is a privilege of NSC membership; if you do not pay down your chit quarterly, you will LOSE this privilege. Also, under no circumstances are NON-members allowed to carry a chit; if you invite friends/family to the club, you are encouraged to put their drinks on your own chit, and they can pay you directly (or you can offer to buy their drinks!). If they insist on paying themselves, they can do so directly to the bar, using the register/cashbox, but please do NOT put a chit in the safe with their name on it...I won't know who they are or if/how they paid. Our chit system, although completely manual, does allow for us to properly keep overall inventory of beverages; therefore, it is important that you follow the above rules. If you have any questions, do not hesitate to contact me. Thank you SO much for your cooperation!









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
